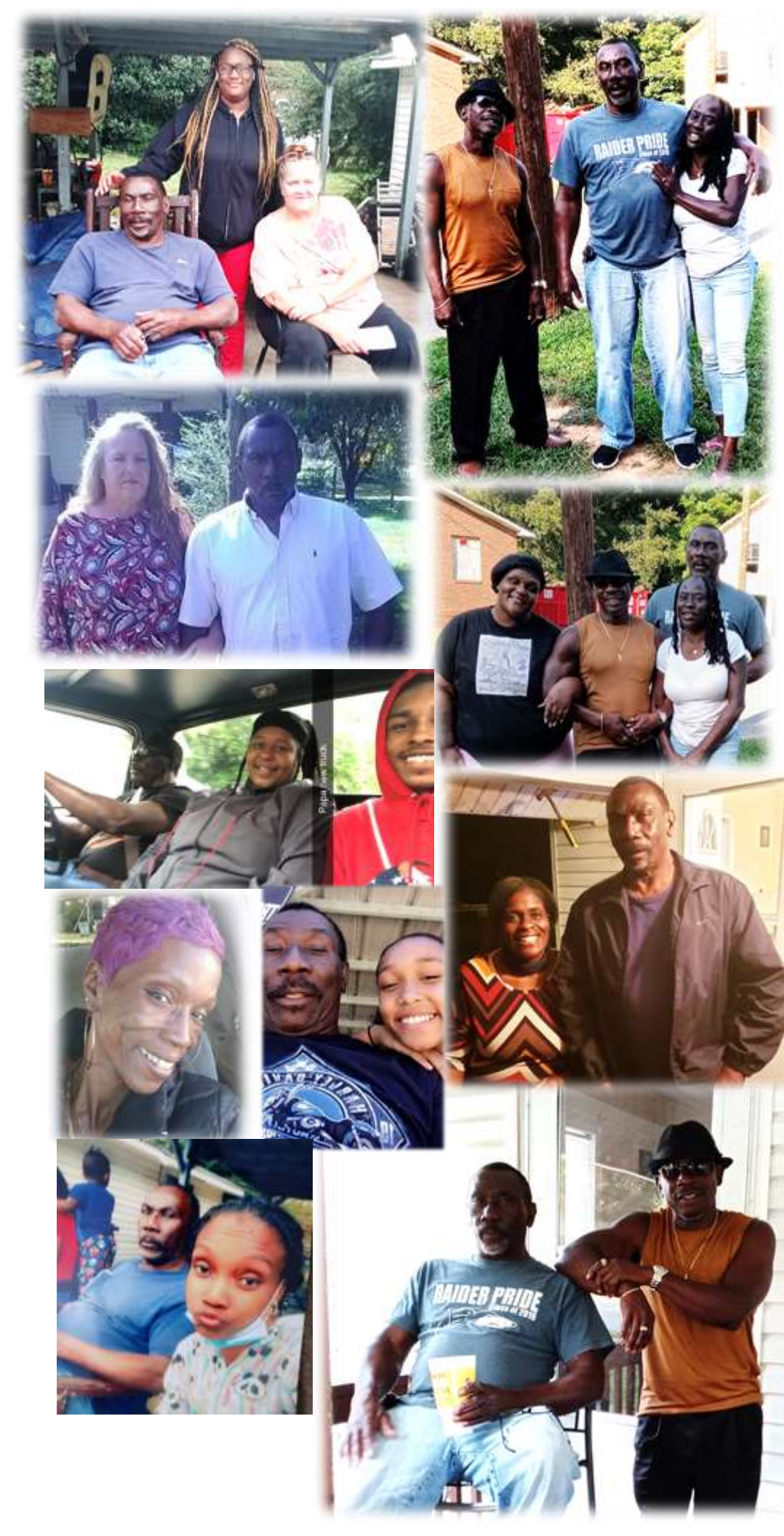

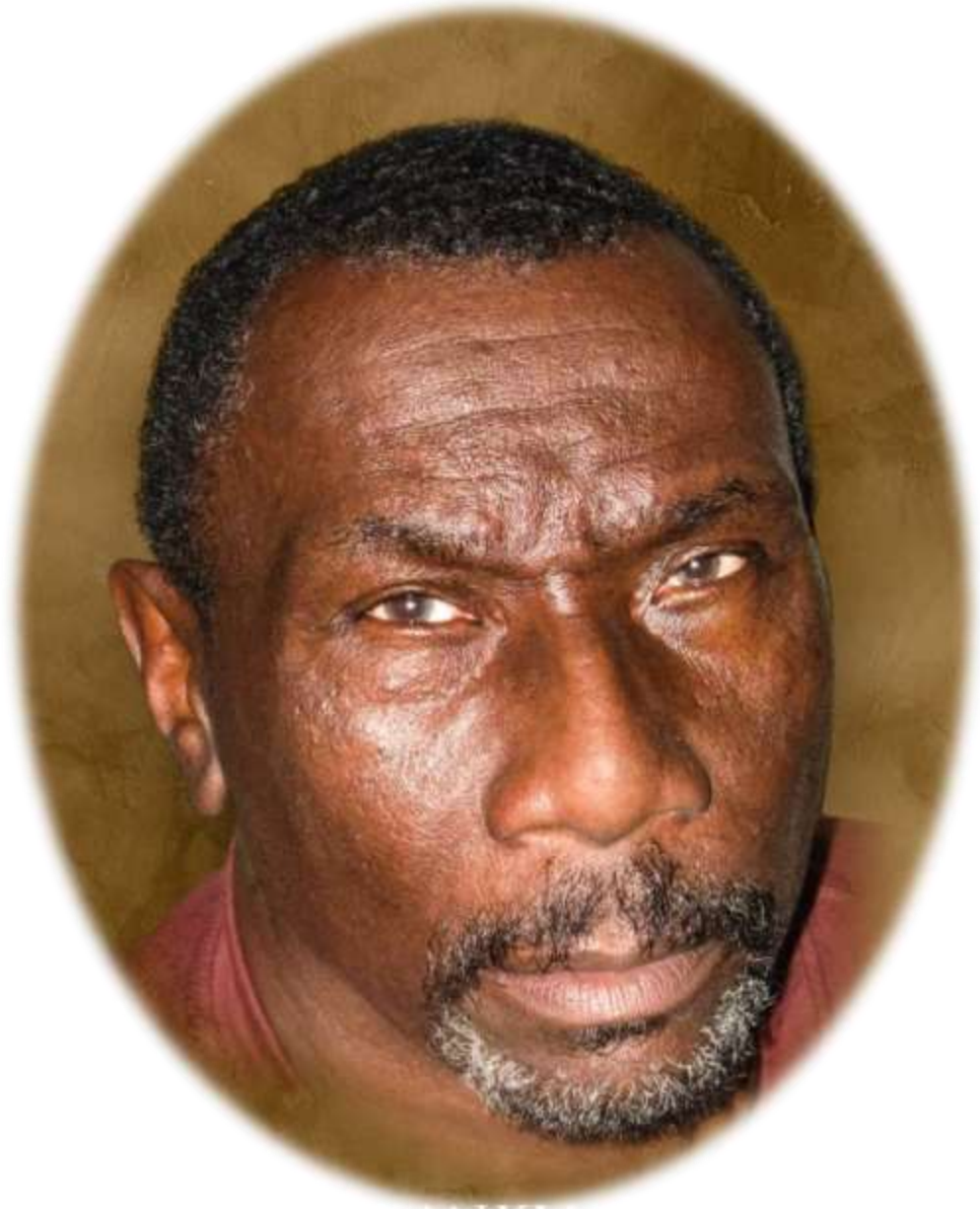


I'm Free
