

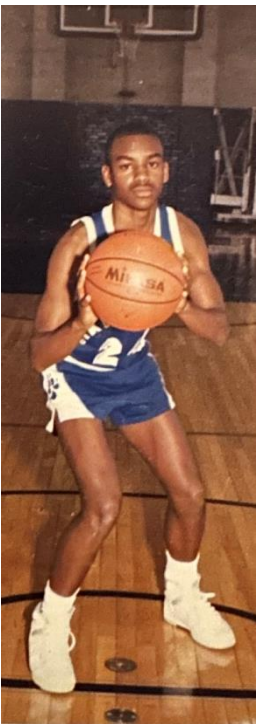
The Family Tribute

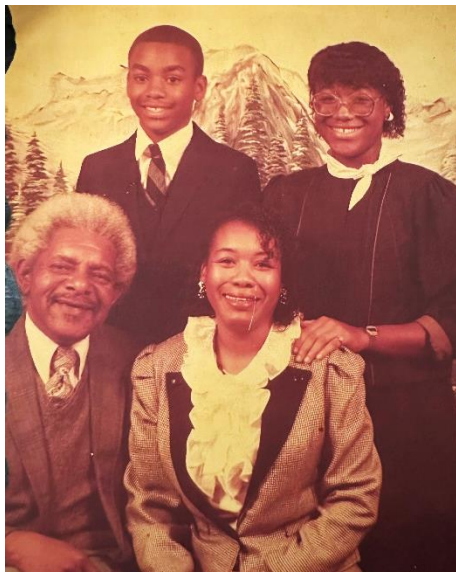
