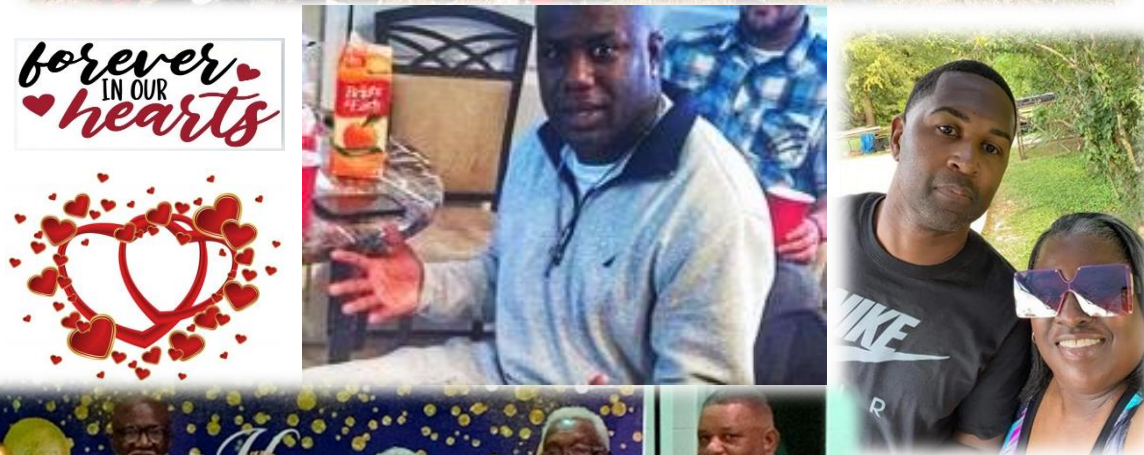

Never selfish, always kind, these are the memories she leaves behind...*

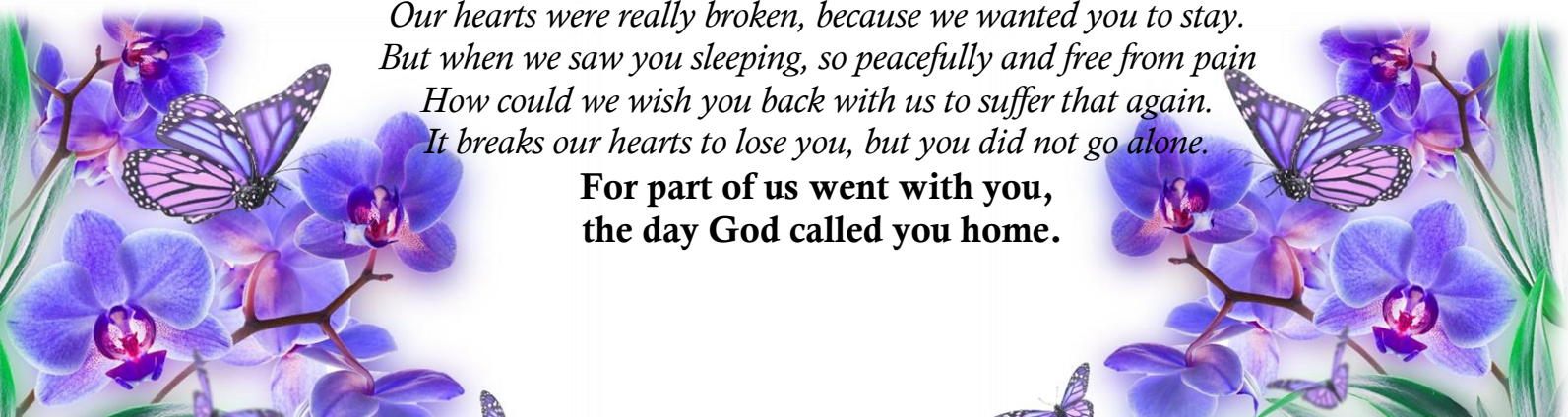
